



Transfer Guide for Baccalaureate Yeshiva Degrees

United States University (USU) is a regionally accredited institution of higher learning offering degrees in information technology, business, education, health sciences, liberal arts, and nursing with a mission to serve underserved groups through campus and online courses that are affordable, accessible, and relevant.

USU has a non-exclusive agreement with Teacher Education Assessment and Management (TEAM) to refer candidates to USU who have earned a baccalaureate degree in Jewish studies.

USU and TEAM acknowledge that USU is committed to providing educational opportunities and services to its students. Each organization shall not discriminate and is dedicated to serving students from all walks of life, regardless of race, ethnicity, sex, sexual orientation, disability, color, age, national origin, medical disabilities/conditions (as defined by law) or any basis prohibited by law.

Under the following terms, USU will accept a block transfer for college graduates with a Yeshiva degree into USU's Bachelor of Arts in Liberal Studies (except Teaching Credential Track) program. Students may receive a block transfer of 85 semester credits.

- a) Completed degree with a Grade Point Average of 2.0 or above ("C" grade or better for each course);
- b) Satisfy all institutional general admissions and program specific admission requirements, if applicable;

To obtain a baccalaureate degree at United States University students are required to complete the courses outlined (or their approved equivalent) below, including any prerequisites. A minimum of 30 credits must be completed at USU in order to confer the Bachelor's degree.

Fees and Payment. There will be no exchange of funds between the parties. Each party shall be solely responsible for and shall bear all costs of its own business.

Term. The MOU commences on the 11/09/2020 and continues for a one-year period. The Term will automatically renew for a single successive twelve (12) month periods if both parties agree to continue.

Termination. Either party may immediately terminate the MOU by notice in writing to the other party if the other party:
a. commits a material breach of the MOU that is incapable of remedy; or
b. 30 days of receiving written notice to the other party.

Acting as Finder Only; Non-Exclusivity. It is understood that TEAM is acting as a finder only and shall not have authority to enter into any agreements, obligations or commitments on USU's behalf, or to negotiate on behalf of USU.

Independent Contractor. The relationship between the parties created by the MOU is that of independent contractors, and nothing in the MOU creates any partnership, joint venture or any form of fiduciary relationship or contract of employment between the parties.

Assignment. No party may assign its rights under the MOU without the prior consent of the other party.

Confidentiality. "Confidential Information", in relation to a party (Discloser), means the terms of the MOU and all information of any nature and in any form concerning the operations, dealings, organization, personnel, business strategies, customers, FERPA protecting information, technology, intellectual property rights, trade secrets or know-how of the Discloser and/or any customer, supplier of the Discloser party, disclosed or made available to the other party (Recipient), disclosed after the date of the MOU, but does not include information which: i. is or becomes part of the public domain other than by breach of the MOU; ii. was already known to it at the time of disclosure by the Discloser; iii. the Recipient acquires from a source other than the Discloser. A Recipient will not, during the term of the MOU or after, disclose the Confidential Information of the other party Discloser to any third party except: i. with the Discloser's prior written consent; ii. as required by law; or iii. to its employees, officers, professional advisers or other agents (Agents) on a need to know basis for the purposes of the MOU. If the Recipient becomes aware of a suspected or actual breach of this clause by the Recipient or an Agent, the Recipient will immediately notify the Discloser.

Publicity: Each party will not issue any press release or other public communication relating to the other without the express prior written consent.

Governing Law. This Agreement and performance hereunder shall be governed by the laws of California. Any actions or proceedings based on this Agreement shall be brought only in the state or federal courts located in the County of San Diego, State of California.
