Here are 20 sample questions to use when interviewing someone in your desired field.

- 1. What are your main duties/responsibilities in a typical day (or week)?
- 2. What do you like most about your work?
- 3. What do you like least about your work?
- 4. What kinds of challenges are you addressing?
- 5. What kinds of decisions do you make every week?
- 6. How does your job affect your general lifestyle?
- 7. What current trends in the field should I know about/be aware of?
- 8. What kinds of accomplishments tend to be valued in this field?
- 9. What related fields do you think I should consider looking into?
- 10. How did you become interested in this field/ How did you get your start?
- 11. What steps would you recommend I take to prepare to enter this field?
- 12. What kind of education, training, or background does your job require?
- 13. What skills, abilities, and personal attributes are essential?
- 14. What are the common traits of your recent successful hires?
- 15. What are the most effective strategies for seeking a position in this field?
- 16. What kinds of professional development can help me stay current?
- 17. What knowledge or skills did you wish you had on your first day?
- 18. To your knowledge, what is a typical starting salary range for this position?
- 19. What advice would you give someone who is considering this type of job?
- 20. Can you suggest anyone else I could contact for additional information?
