# UNITED STATES UNIVERSITY COMMENCEMENT GUEST SPEAKER

## Judge Rohanee Zapanta



Judge Zapanta was appointed by California Governor Jerry Brown in December 2018. She is trained and certified in mental health first aid and restorative justice cognitive behavioral therapy. Prior to her appointment, she was an attorney for the San Diego Public Defender's Office, specializing her practice in representing clients with serious mental illness and developmental conditions. She was also an instructor-facilitator of restorative justice courses at the San Diego South Bay Detention Facility. Judge Zapanta presided over adult criminal cases in 2019 and juvenile court cases through the pandemic years of 2020 through 2023. She now presides over mental health cases.

Judge Zapanta is the Co-Chair and Co-Founder of the California Judges Association Ethics and Wellness Workshops, addressing identity and core values for many first-generation lawyers and law students, children of immigrants. She is also Co-Editor of the *The Bench*, the official journal of the California Judges Association, serving one of the largest judicial associations in the United States. She sits on the Alumni Board of Directors

for the University of San Diego and serves on the Diversity Committee for the law school.

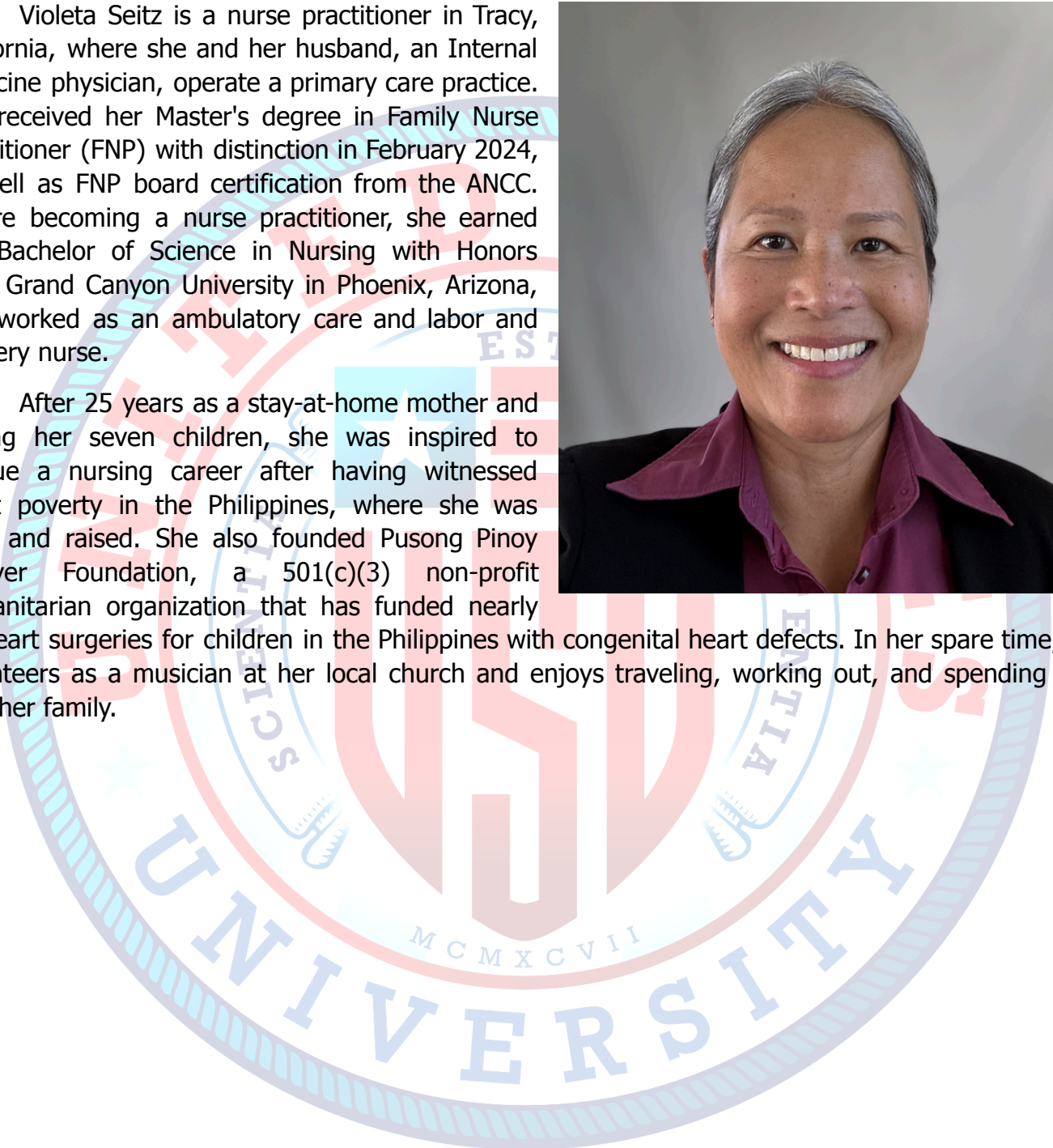
Judge Zapanta works closely with several legal and cultural organizations. She was selected as Juris of the Year in 2019 by the Filipino-American Business Improvement and Development Board. In 2023 Judge Zapanta was named as one of the Top Women of Influence in Law by the San Diego Business Journal. Judge Zapanta received the *Pamana* Legacy Award by *Silayan Filipina* at their 2023 Anniversary Gala. This past October, she was recognized as one of the *Most Influential Filipina Women in the World* for 2023 by the Filipina Women's Network. This prestigious global recognition was presented to her in Prague, Czech Republic where she and a U.S. Presidential Commission Appointee on Asian & Pacific Islanders led a session on Race & Intersectionality at the global summit.

## Violeta Seitz

Violeta Seitz is a nurse practitioner in Tracy, California, where she and her husband, an Internal Medicine physician, operate a primary care practice. She received her Master's degree in Family Nurse Practitioner (FNP) with distinction in February 2024, as well as FNP board certification from the ANCC. Before becoming a nurse practitioner, she earned her Bachelor of Science in Nursing with Honors from Grand Canyon University in Phoenix, Arizona, and worked as an ambulatory care and labor and delivery nurse.

After 25 years as a stay-at-home mother and raising her seven children, she was inspired to pursue a nursing career after having witnessed great poverty in the Philippines, where she was born and raised. She also founded Pusong Pinoy Forever Foundation, a 501(c)(3) non-profit humanitarian organization that has funded nearly 40 heart surgeries for children in the Philippines with congenital heart defects. In her spare time, she volunteers as a musician at her local church and enjoys traveling, working out, and spending time with her family.



# COMMENCEMENT REGALIA AND HONOR CORDS

Academic regalia (cap, gown, and hood) in the United States has been influenced by the academic dress traditions of Europe. This includes a long flowing gown, usually black, and sleeves that are indicative of the degree obtained. Master's level sleeves have pointed cuffs. Academic hoods have several components:

**Shell:** The shell material of the hood typically matches the robe. This is traditionally black.

**Interior Lining:** Typically satin, the interior indicates the colors of the institution from which the graduate received the degree. United States University's hoods have a red and blue interior lining.

**Trim:** The outer edge of the cowl is trimmed in velvet or velveteen. The color of the velvet/velveteen hood trimming is distinctive in the academic field and varies by major.

## United States University's Hood Colors

Business Degree: Drab (light brown)

Education & Liberal Studies Degree: Light Blue

Health Sciences Degree: Sage Green

Nursing Degree: Apricot

Colorful honor cords have a tassel on each end, and they are worn around the honoree's neck, so that the strands hang down the graduation gown, signifying academic achievements. Honor cords recognize academic excellence achieved throughout the duration of a student's entire academic career. Eligibility for the three categories of undergraduate Latin Honors (Summa Cum Laude, Magna Cum Laude, & Cum Laude) is based on the cumulative grade point average for all coursework at United States University. Students are recognized at commencement with honors levels.

Summa Cum Laude - *with highest honor* - 3.80-4.00

Magna Cum Laude - *with great honor* - 3.65-3.79

Cum Laude - *with honor* - 3.50-3.64

Graduate students with a cumulative grade point average of 3.7 or above will be recognized and awarded the status of "With Distinction."
